MEDIAN INCOME BY RESIDENTAL COMMUNITY - CALGARY, 2005


Comparison of 2D and 3D Representations


According to Statistics Canada the median household income in Calgary, in 2005 was \$82,800. This figure indicates that about 69% of all residential communities had a median household income below the city average. In the maps presented here, 17% of all communities were in the lowest class, while 1.6% of all communities were in the highest class. The classes immediately above or below the median comprise 50% of all residential communities.
